Poettker Construction Finishes Award-Winning Year with \$404 Million in Revenue

Poettker’s Midwest and Southeast teams constructed 4.7 million square feet of new facilities across 94 projects in the areas of distribution and warehouse, federal and defense, healthcare, education, industrial, manufacturing, senior living, hospitality, retail and utility infrastructure.

“In 2024, Poettker Construction began building its largest single school project to date with Cahokia High School,” said Ryan Poettker, President of Poettker Construction. “The education sector is particularly special to us because it gives us an opportunity to engage and get the next generation excited about the construction process of their facilities, as well as career opportunities within the industry. Distinguished Projects

Completion of the 80,000-square-foot Pana Elementary School in June marked an exceptional achievement with 2,140 tons of precast concrete panels set and 364 tons of structural steel, joists and decking installed.

Of note within the Distribution & Warehouse sector, construction has been completed for the 472,000-square-foot Innovation Logistics Center in Salisbury, North Carolina, which features 162 load-bearing concrete tilt-up panels and 84 dock doors.

In the Federal & Defense sector, the Poettker team at the Scott Air Force Base Joint Operations & Mission Planning Center continues to exemplify outstanding safety performance by completing over 382,000 work hours without a lost time incident.

Award-Winning Performance

The Associated Builders and Contractors awarded Poettker the No. 102 spot on its Top Performers List, as well as the No. 3 Top Retail Contractor, No. 16 Top Military Contractor, No. 51 Top General Contractor and a 2024 Accredited Quality Contractor.
